St John's Day Centre - Your Central Library

Approximately 10% of Swansea's population are aged 75 and over. While we're thankful for the advances that have seen life-expectancy rise to this point, longer lives bring their own challenges. At St John's Day Centre in Cwmbwrla, those challenges are met with love and respect.

Centre manager Amanda Gallivan sets the tone, giving local people a meeting place, a project management hub and a wellness centre. The youngest current attendee at St John's is 54 years old, and there are others in their late 90s. Over the years Amanda has helped people celebrate 100th birthdays. And in her eyes, these people's lives are something to be celebrated.

At St John's they are guaranteed a greeting from highly trained, compassionate professionals who make each day count. They offer care balanced with respect, always reaffirming each person's sense of identity and self-worth. And with the centre also proving to be a magnet for younger people, attracting employees and volunteers of all ages, it offers visitors warmth and vibrancy that keeps them coming back day after day. And the centre also offers excellent training and meeting facilities which make it a suitable training hub for individuals and organisations.

The Wales People's Library History Wing

What's your definition of history?

The Wales People's Library Arts Wing

A 1949 BBC radio broadcast famously brought together the Kardomah Gang of Dylan Thomas, poet Vernon Watkins, composer Daniel Jones, writer John Pritchard and artist Alfred Janes to discuss the future of the arts in Swansea as we moved into the second half of the 20th century.

But now we're well into the 21st. Who are the new artists who will inspire us? They may be following a traditional path, or they may be finding new outlets for their talent.

Which creative paths will our musicians follow in the 2020s? Will our most creative minds be writing novels or will they be podcasting?

There's no reason why they can't do both. The **Arts Wing** will meet to share our thoughts on and our hopes
for the arts in the 2020s and beyond.

The Wales People's Library Science Wing

Science encompasses traditional advancements in biology, chemistry and physics, of course, and it also includes developments in technology that shape our everyday lives in ways we might not recognise.

On this planet right now there are far more devices connected to the internet than there are people. 250 miles above us there's an international space station that uses the same cloud technology to keep its systems running that many of us use to do our jobs.

Around us in Swansea there are businesses that don't just use technology to keep moving forward, they use it to safeguard the environment.

And artificial intelligence is doing more and more of the jobs that, even a few years ago, would have taken up huge amounts of our time. It's not a threat to us, it's giving us a platform to use our skills and do the things that only people can do.

Meetings of the **Science Wing** will discuss where we go next.
